

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
of the  
City of Northfield Council  
August 23, 2021**

In keeping with the Coronavirus safety procedures, the regular meeting of the City of Northfield Council was held on Monday August 23, 2021, using the Zoom Meeting computer program. Council members attending: Sharon Berger, Steve Levy, Tim Martin, Clark Rhea, Brandon Smith and Tracy Walker. City officials present: Mayor Randolph Chappell, Police Chief Tom David, City Engineer Adrian Oliver and City Clerk Phyllis Onachilla.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., by Mayor Chappell.

**MINUTES**

Minutes of the July 26, 2021, meeting were approved as distributed.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**

Council members reviewed the Income Statement, the Balance Sheet and the City's List of Investments for the General Fund as of July 31, 2021. They also reviewed the Income Statement and the Balance Sheet for the Road Fund for the month ending July 31, 2021, and the General Ledger and Check Register for the period from July 1 to July 31, 2021.

**CLERK'S REPORT**

The City of Northfield's 2021 tax bills will be mailed in September and due on or before October 31, 2021.

Henry W. Jr. and Margaret Dimmitt, 6100 Stannye Drive, are new residents in Northfield.

**POLICE REPORT**

Police Chief Tom David briefed council members on recent activities throughout the city including nine dispatch calls for service from JCSO, eleven calls for service from residents, three non-injury accidents, and one hit and run accident; vehicle and driver were located. Three homeless subjects were assisted and several hundred dollars of stolen property from CVS and Kroger's were recovered and returned. Four citations were issued this month.

Mayor Chappell asked Chief David to step up patrol and cite drivers who roll through our "Stop" signs; particularly drivers on Lime Kiln Lane who cut through Glenview Manor and Northfield to eliminate a portion of Route 42.

**NUISANCE ORDINANCE**

The Ordinance Amending Regulations Concerning Restriction of Nuisances, adopted on February 23, 2015, was discussed. Council members determined that this ordinance should be updated, and Mr. Martin agreed to prepare an amendment for Council's approval.
